# HISTORY

some say that history is a poem – each event a stanza, every moment a verse.

If that's the case, then consider Mohican Country a sonnet: A long and storied tale that spans from recent memory back to the first European settlers, to our Delaware Native American (Lenape) "Grandfathers," and into the millennia of natural history and the ice age of Ohio, which helped shape Mohican's scenic beauty: the Clear Fork Gorge, the Mohican River and old-growth white pine and hemlock forest.

Indulge your inner history enthusiast on a self-guided tour to the old Ohio Theatre (1909) and the once-home of Phillip J. Black (1865), today both honored on the National Register of Historic Places. Hike into former Native American hunting grounds and walk in the steps of John Chapman, who most of us know now as Johnny Appleseed. Explore a working grist mill and cross the Greenville Treaty line of 1795, which once delineated the border between Native American lands and the United States.

# VENTURE OUT TO MOHICAN

he Mohican outdoors – a wild land that bottles magic and decants adventure, that captures imaginations and wins hearts. Here, the journey begins long before you arrive: a dream, a plan, a hope for what awaits. And then, drive, a hike, a forge into the forest, the river, the lake.

As they say, it's not just the destination, but the journey there. Although, in Mohican, the destination is outstanding, too.

Because some things you can only ponder with each strike of your hiking boots upon the trail. Some experiences are reserved for those willing to take up an oar and paddle into the wild. Some moments effervesce only as you trot through the woods or fly into a forest canopy. And some thrills, some panoramas, some encounters are only possible when you venture out into Mohican.

#### R ARCHERY

In a place best known for its opportunities to stretch your legs and find the rhythm of your paddle, Mohican now invites you to polish another skill set:

Grab your bow and arrows, loosen your shoulders, and train your eye because Mohican State Park recently inaugurated a new public archery range, open dawn to dusk and offering targets at 10, 20, 30, 40, and 50 yards.

#### 🕅 HIKING

An outdoor wonderland of woods and gorges, rivers and overlooks, Mohican is the kind of place labeled as breathtaking, no matter what you do. But, if you want to up the ante and go beyond breathtaking, then you'll have to hit the trails!

Strap on your hiking boots: Mohican is home to over 88 miles of trails that connect Malabar Farm State Park, Mohican State Park and State Forest, and Pleasant Hill Lake Park. Numerous loops, paths, and tracks wend and wind through land and water, climbing to stunning views and unmatched sights, including Mohican's famous Covered Bridge, Clear Fork Gorge, Pleasant Hill Lake, Lyons Falls, Wolf Creek Grist Mill, and the Mohican State Scenic River.

The Mohican Cable Pedestrian Bridge at Mohican State Park, a 120-foot-long thrill and ode to Mother Nature. Promising an exhilarating link between Hemlock Gorge Trail and the Gorge Overlook Trail, the suspension bridge traverses the Clear Fork River, now designated a State Scenic River.

**Note:** Hikers are welcome to tackle the State Park's bridle and mountain biking trails. Please give right-of-way to riders on these trails.

#### 💑 BIKING

Load up your bikes, grab your helmets! Mohican is a cyclist's paradise, where stunning adventures hide along every stretch of the dedicated mountain bike trails that crisscross our landscapes.

For those seeking the bold and the breathtaking, pedal onto 30 miles of mountain bike trail at Mohican State Park and State Forest, considered the best trail in Ohio. Ride the entire length if you have the lungs; or, ride a portion, if you don't.

Rails to Trails has seen several bike paths created around the Mohican area. A 2-mile, paved bike path connects downtown Loudonville with Mohican State Park and the Wolf Creek Grist Mill, while the B & O Trail is a 26-mile route running connect in Knox County, taking cyclists across the Bridge of Dreams near Brinkhaven.

An all-ages, small mountain bike park is now located across from the Mohican State Park Lodge. The adventurous trail and easy-moderate pump track include several quarter-and half-mile loops to encourage skill progression, and also connect to the Pleasant Hill dam for a fluid biking experience.

#### HORSEBACK RIDING

Hook up your horse trailer and experience Mohican from the unparalleled perspective of an equestrian: atop a saddle and in rhythm with your mount, as Ohio explorers have done for centuries.

The area offers miles of public-use bridle trails that connect Mohican State Park and State Forest with Pleasant Hill Lake Park and Malabar Farm State Park, cantering from beginner into advanced territory.

#### SKIING, SNOWBOARDING & MORE

Mohican may be best known for its warm-weather activities, but there's more to our great outdoors than spring-and-summer pursuits.

With intrepid winter escapades in mind, recent years have welcomed a rise in snow-dusted recreation, including cross-country and downhill skiing, snowboarding snow tubing, and other cold-weather sports.

Today, Mohican Memorial State Forest plays host to an 8-mile snowmobiling trail, while local attractions promise skiing, snowboarding, and snow tubing. This year, embrace the simple and timeless pleasures of being outdoors: lifting your face to the sun, inhaling the scents of the forest, summiting a path to reveal epic views. Disappear into the wilds, escape from technology, and surround yourself with no one and yet, everything. Get outward bound in Mohican.








# **CANOEING** Whether it's been a month, a year, or a lifetime – when you pick up that paddle, you know you're home. Because the Mohican is always there: a welcoming stretch of river that wends and winds from Loudonville to Greer, hugging the Wally Road Scenic Byway while carving out a swath of aquatic paradise all its own.

This meandering ribbon is the reason – the genesis, the heart, and the passion – for why Mohican is the reigning Canoe Capital of Ohio. Born of entrepreneurial inspiration and nurtured through an abiding love for paddle sport, Mohican's canoe livery tradition has endured, thrived, and flourished for over 50 years.

Today, the Mohican River – and we, its eponymous region, parks, and places – welcome the state's greatest number of registered canoes and the highest concentration of paddling activities: canoeing and kayaking, rafting and tubing. And for you, that means choice: Choice of how and where to paddle – of how fast the river, how long the challenge, and how exhilarating the adventure. We call it your paddle power.

Don't miss the State Scenic Mohican Water Trail, which flows from Loudonville to Greer and hugs the Wally Road Scenic Byway, serving as Ohio's largest outdoor recreational complex. As you paddle down the river, you'll see remnants of the historic Walhonding – "The Wally" – and may even spot bald eagles or river otters in their natural habitat.

Most canoe and kayaking trips take two to six hours. Liveries typically open April through October.

**Note:** Ohio law forbids operating a watercraft while under the influence of alcohol. As such, open containers are not permitted on the river. And remember - we share the water with boaters of all ages. Courtesy goes a long way!

## SPORTING EVENTS

o vacation deliberately is to actively pursue that which you seek: To chase your goals, be they a sunrise on the mountain-top, a 100-mile trek through pristine forest, or a medal around your neck.

The great outdoors is a Mohican tradition – even more so, when paired with physical challenge, endurance, and a bit of friendly competition. Because, while there are a myriad of ways to get outside and push your body to its limits, there's nothing quite like the thrill of a Mohican sporting event: Spring- through-autumn individual and family challenges that summon athletes from around the world, to tackle river, stream, hill, and trail.

In April, lace up your running shoes for the first races of the season, with Forget the PR Mohican 50k and 25k. Then, get off your feet and pedal your way into May's Mohican Mountain Bike 100, a legendary 100-mile /100-kilometer (your choice) ultra-endurance loop with a total elevation gain over 11,000 feet.

Or, challenge your running mettle with June's Mohican 100 Trail Run, a race trifecta that offers tiered options to run 100 miles, 50 miles, or the Mohican Marathon: Ohio's only off-road marathon, this testament to perseverance travels the pristine trails of the 5,000-acre Mohican-Memorial State Forest.

Come fall, take it easy (or, easier) during the Mohican 5K Run/Walk along the Loudonville-Mohican bike path; or, November's Fuzzy Fandango, a family-friendly 5K to 50K, held along scenic park trails.

This year, challenge yourself to chase goals in Mohican.

ohican begs you step outside and make some memories – again and again, year after year. Because, whether this is your first visit or an annual pilgrimage, our schedule of events fills the calendar with long hikes and festive fireworks, live music and family fun.

Stave off cabin fever at the year's first big event: Winterfest, which gathers at Loudonville's Central Park and will see frozen creations crafted by award-winning ice sculptors. Come March, indulge your sweet tooth and tap into a Mohican tradition at Malabar Farm State Park's Maple Syrup Festival.

As much as Mohican loves snow-dusted landscapes and winter cheer, our events calendar really kicks into high gear come spring. April welcomes the **Mohican Wildlife Weekend**, a family-friendly celebration of wildlife habitat, heritage, and natural history. Do more than just get up-closeand-personal with your favorite animals: hike our trails, explore Ohio's natural wonders, and learn a new skill.

Looking forward to the start of summer? There's no better welcome to the season than Memorial Day in Mohican: Beginning with the **Mohican Arts and Crafts Festival** – an homage to great food, superb craftsmanship, and the joys of a season of outdoor promise – the weekend only improves as downtown Loudonville honors our troops at the traditional **Memorial Day Parade**. Come June, Mohican toasts to the International Wine Festival at the Mill Fundraiser, featuring nearly 100 varieties of international and Ohio wines, domestic beers, and great food at the Mill. It's a perfect pairing with July's Fourth of July fireworks and award-winning Loudonville Classic Car Show. Speaking of fireworks, Christmas in July is also in full and festive swing at Pleasant Hill Lake.

As the weather transitions into the crisp winds of autumn, Mohican throws a party – or five! Reserve your tickets for the **Mohican Bluegrass Festival**, an outdoor celebration featuring the best in bluegrass. Next up, the **Mohican Pow-Wow** celebrates Native American dance, culture, artisan goods, and food. Soon to follow, **Log Cabin Days** takes you back to simpler times with exhibits and demonstrations of rustic carving, hand- hewing, peeling and more. Come late September, **Oktoberfest at the Mill** delivers an outdoor food-and-music festival. **Ohio Heritage Days** at Malabar Farm State Park introduce visitors to 18th century living, Civil War re-enactments, wagon rides, music, and much more. Finish out the year during December's Loudonville Christmas Parade, Mohican Castle's Festival of Lights, and Malabar Farm State Park's Candlelight Holiday Tour. ## WHERE TO STAY

hat do a majestic castle, cozy lodges, and authentic treehouses have in common?

Answer: They can all be your home-away-fromhome in Mohican. Whether you're in town for a day or a week, our diverse accommodations – from log cabins, cottages and bed & breakfasts, to hotels, inns and resorts – play welcoming hosts to fireside evenings and outdoor picnics, expansive porches and solitary walks in the woods.

Embrace period charm at a 19th century Victorian landmark listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Settle into recently renovated, two-bedroom cabins, ensconced in centenarian forest and surrounded by aerial adventures.
